


# LONG LAKE OUTDOOR EDUCATION CENTRE

## Information Package


Built in 1981, Long Lake Outdoor Education Centre is operated under Alberta Sustainable Resource Development in the Public Outreach and Web Services branch.

Facility rentals are available for organizations with a mandate for youth and/or natural resource education. The facility is open mid-February to mid-November. Youth organizations, clubs, and schools use the facility as a base for teachings and for wilderness experiences. The facility is surrounded by 83 acres of boreal forest and resides next to a quiet, pristine lake full of wildlife.

## Full-Site Rental

Long Lake Centre is a modern, rustic facility with a comfortable capacity of 80 people in the summer and 56 when the snow falls. The facility promotes a 'leave as found' philosophy both for structures and wildlife.

### Dining hall and kitchen

Capacity: 90 people  
Full screen, projector, DVD player and speakers.  
Full commercial kitchen and buffet table  
Heat Source: Forced Air, wood fireplace

### Cabins with wood stoves

Capacity: 100+ beds in 14 cabins  
Heat Source: Wood Stove, no electricity

### Shower house

Capacity: 5 Men's showers with private stalls and 5 Women's showers with private stalls.  
Heat Source: Forced Air

### Outhouses

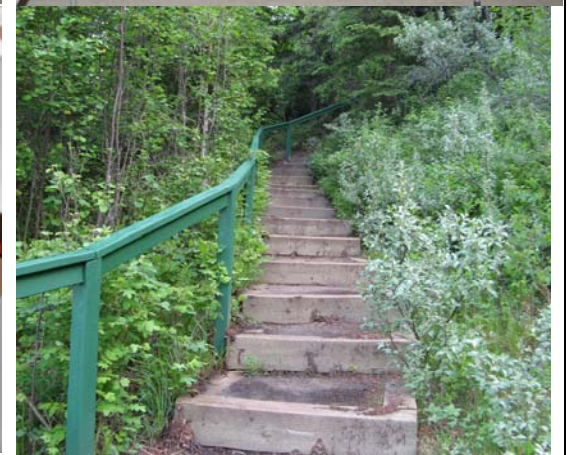
Capacity: 4 heated and 13 non-heated.  
Heat Source: Electric

### Waterfront

Capacity: 1.85km of waterfront with a swimming dock and boating dock.  
Uses: fishing, bird watching, canoeing and swimming.

### First Aid Room

Capacity: 2 beds, 3-piece bathroom  
AED, Oxygen, private phone and first aid supplies  
Heat Source: Forced Air



## Other Rentals Available

In addition to full-site bookings, equipment and some areas are available independently. Cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, canoeing are activities available on-site or equipment can be used off-site. Please contact the facility with inquiries.

### Bunk house

Capacity: 5 beds, one private room.

Heat Source: Forced Air

Capacity: For groups up to 20.  
Available with full-site rental. Cross Country Skis are available on a weekly bases for off-site rental.
